The foot bone was not attached to her leg bone; and when she tried to walk on it, she was actually walking on the end of her leg bone. Her foot just flopped around. We made the decision to amputate the leg. Since the operation, she is doing amazingly well. In fact Madison was dancing around the day after surgery!

In addition, Madison was so badly matted and her hair was so full of feces, it was impossible to shave her. So she had to be sedated to be shaved down. And look what a little doll was hiding under all that mess! The great news is that Madison has been adopted and is now loving her life in Florida with her new family!

SCMR received a call from a fellow rescue about six Maltese who were in need of being placed. We took these terribly neglected and scared kids under our wing and have given them the best care available. Each dog was badly matted, the hair embedded with feces. Their nails were so long, they curled around and made a full circle. Several dogs could not see because the hair on the top of their heads was matted to the hair on their faces. Many could hardly move because of dense matting on their legs. We were unable to determine where Melony's ears were because they were completely matted to her neck. It took two hours to slowly cut through the matts to free her ears, so they could be shaved. Already, three of these six have been adopted!!!!!! TREATS FOR TRICKS!

Muttzoh Balls

- 1 cup Any natural dry dog food
- 2 Eggs, beaten lightly
- 1 teaspoon Polyunsaturated oil
- 1/3 cup Cold water
- Sprinkle of garlic powder
- 1/2 cup Chicken soup OR 2 chicken bouillon cubes

Grind dry dog food smooth in a food processor or blender. Lightly beat egg and add oil. Mix all moist ingredients together except soup. Add to dry ingredients. Form into 1/2" balls. In large pan, bring 1 quart water to boiling to which you have added 1/2 cup chicken soup or the 2 bouillon cubes. Drop balls into boiling water. Boil for 3 minutes. Remove from water, drain and cool. Refrigerate. 🐾
