



## Pumpkin Peanut Butter Treats



### Ingredients

- 2 ½ cups whole wheat flour
- 2 tablespoons peanut butter
- 2 eggs
- ½ teaspoon ground cinnamon
- ½ cup canned pumpkin
- ½ teaspoon salt

### Directions

- Step 1 Preheat oven to 350 degrees F (175 degrees C).
- Step 2 Whisk together the flour, eggs, pumpkin, peanut butter, salt, and cinnamon in a bowl. Add water as needed to help make the dough workable, but the dough should be dry and stiff. Roll the dough into a 1/2-inch-thick roll. Cut into 1/2-inch pieces.
- Step 3 Bake in preheated oven until hard, about 40 minutes. 🐾
